

- Moldy Wine

- Uniform Grey

- Dark Tone


- Runic Grey Speedpaint

PAINTING KEY

















TIP:

Block in all the other colours first, then come back at the end to tidy up the Matt White shirt. It keeps things neat - especially if your brush strays when paiting the black straps!







TIP:

Thin down the Strong Skin Shade and Runic Grey Speedpaint with Warpaints Stabilizer for the skin and cloth. This softens the finish, and you can add extra coats for deeper shadows if necessary.







TIP:

For a warmer, reddish tint to the skintones, thin down Moldy Wine with Warpaints Stabilizer to make a wash. Apply it carefully into the recesses of the sculpt to add contrast and colour variation.







TIP:

Layer Buffed Hide back onto the skin, leaving the reddish tones showing through in the shaded areas for extra depth.







BACKPACK DETAILS



TIP.

A few bright colours were painted on to the buttons and backpack lights to help those details stand out more.
