



- Shining Silver


Strong Tone

PAINTING KEY



Note: Paints used are from The Army Painter range






STEF











TIP:

Start with Deep Grey as the base coat before adding the other colours. Once everything is painted, go back in with Deep Grey to neaten up any spots where paint may have overlapped onto the armour.







BLACK MARKINGS: Matt Black (B)

While painting the camo pattern, rotate the model as you go. This makes it easier to keep control of your brush and paint the irregular shapes more cleanly.













To help the darker cloth stand out from the Grey of the armour, mix a little Deep Grey into your Matt Black for the first highlight.



ARMOUR:

Uniform Grey (H)



CLOTH: Deep Grey (H)
