TIP:


Mix a few small rocks with your sand and fix them in place with PVA glue to give the base more texture and variety. For extra detail, add 'bricks' like those from the plastic Konflikt '47 ruins kit.






UNDERCOAT: Matt Black Spray










TIP:

Use an Army Painter Wargamer Large Drybrush to pick out the raised sand texture and the edges of the bricks. Don't worry about being too precise, if a little Prairie Ochre catches thy bricks it will still look natural.









BRICKS: Soft Tone (W)

TIP:

Thin down some Soft Tone with a little water and brush a light coat over the bricks. This will give them a subtle dirty weathered look - Perfect for that battle worn feel!
