ARMIES OF SOVIET UNION - ERRATA

PAGE 28, Hammer and Sickle, Naval Brigade

ADD the following sentence at the end:

Note that SMGs cost only 3pts if given to units with this rule.

PAGE 29, Guard Dogs

ADD the following sentence at the end:

Note that SMGs cost only 3pts if given to a model with a guard dog.

PAGE 46, MMG Team

ADD the following Option:

- The entire team may have SN-42 body armour for +15pts.

PAGE 47, Anti-Tank Rifle Team

ADD the following Option:

Hammer and Sickle: Airborne, NKVD, Naval Brigade.

PAGE 49, Dog Mines Anti-Tank Team

CHANGE the last line of the Special rules as follows:

5–6: The dog scampers to the target and crawls underneath it. The vehicle suffers a hit with a Pen of +3 (no Pen modifiers or cover saves apply).

PAGE 63. T-50 Light Infantry Tank

ADD the following option:

- May add a second co-axial MMG for +10pts

PAGE: 86, Aerosan

CHANGE the Transport line as follows:

Transport: Up to 5 men (must be equipped with skis)

Does the Victory banner work if the unit carrying it is inside a building or is being transported?

The best way to treat this is to match the way the special abilities of a company commander work, even when carried by a non-officer squad. So, if the unit carrying it is in an open-topped vehicle, the range of the banner is measured to the hull of the transport. If the unit is in a fully enclosed transport, the banner only works on units inside the transport. If in a building, it can be used by friendly units occupying a floor immediately above or below the banner's unit in the same building, or within 12" of any opening the model carrying banner would be able to shoot out of.

When resolving an air strike, the roll on the Warplane Type Table comes after the 'resolving flak' procedure, so how can I know if the target plane is a 'flying tank' when resolving flak?

When a Soviet warplane arrives, roll for the type of plane before resolving the flak, then resolve the flak, and finally, if the warplane has not been driven off, resolve the attack on the target unit.

I found that there were many Valentine IXs and Matilda Mk II CS sent as land-lease to the Soviet Union, can I use them in my army?

Yes, you can use the following two entries from Armies of Great Britain as a land-lease tank:

- Infantry Tank Mk II Matilda II & IIC (page 60 of Armies of Great Britain)
- Infantry Tank Mk III Valentine VIII-X (page 61 of Armies of Great Britain)

If a dog mine attacks a friendly vehicle with the Recce special rule, is it allowed to escape the attack?

Yes, just like an enemy recce vehicle would.

What exactly counts as a 'tank' for the purposes of the tank riders special rules?

Any fully tracked and fully enclosed armoured vehicle (i.e. the same as for the purposes of tanks assaulting infantry).
